The ***Australian Primary Mathematics Classroom (APMC)*** is published four times a year by AAMT. It is a journal written for anyone interested in primary mathematics education, but is primarily for classroom teachers. It considers current issues, encouraging reflection of practice, and promotes innovation as part of the evolving nature of mathematical pedagogy.

The ***Australian Mathematics Teacher (AMT)*** is published in four issues each year by AAMT. It is a journal to serve as a medium both for the exchange of ideas and experiences in the teaching of mathematics and for the instruction of teachers in the trends and developments of mathematics education at home and abroad. Aimed at teachers of mathematics in Years 7–10.

The ***Australian Senior Mathematics Journal (ASMJ)*** focuses on the teaching of mathematics for Years 11, 12 and early tertiary years. There are two issues each year, published by AAMT.
